

Family Resource Center at Landmark Hill

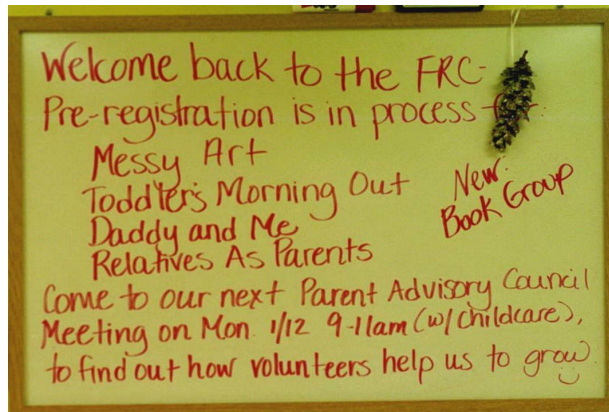


The Family Resource Center at Landmark Hill, is a new program for Child Care Services of York County. This program is a collaborative project led by Child Care Services of York County (CCSYC) in partnership with Casey Family Services (CFS) and the Community Wellness Coalition/York Hospital, and is staffed by a full-time director (an employee of Child Care Services of York County) and a Vista volunteer.

The project's primary funding for this project comes from a State of Maine Juvenile Justice crime prevention grant and funding from the United Way of the Greater Seacoast.

The core and comprehensive services of family resource center has been:

- Parent Education (such as classes, support groups, peer-to-peer);
- Child Development Activities (such as Play & Grow, Mommy & Me);
- Life Skills and Advocacy (such as anger management classes, communication skills, budgeting, cooking classes, etc.);
- Family Health and Wellness (health and dental services, medical home, onsite outreach, mental health programs);
- Family Literacy and Education Support (ESL, tutoring, GED Prep, technology center);
- 12. Other elements consistent with the above, as needed and available.



These activities may be provided directly by the Program Director, sub-contracted to an outside entity, or provided at no cost by outside organization. (When activities are provided by outside entities, either sub-contractors or donated by outside organizations, proof of liability insurance will be required.)
